

Important information regarding ticket sales!

1. The ASO offers PREMIUM and STANDARD tickets prices. Details on reverse.
2. Season subscriptions on sale June 1, 2026 by phone, mail, box office, and on-line. Individual concert tickets will go on sale at least 30 days prior to each concert.
3. Fees are waived on full season subscriptions.
4. A 4% credit/debit card fee will be added to all sampler subscriptions and individual tickets. Pay cash or check to avoid the added fee.
5. If you wish to receive your season tickets by mail, please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope.
6. Every effort will be made to honor your seat preferences from the 2025-2026 concert season. If you wish to make a change, you may do so at the time of purchase as long as those seats are available.
7. If a concert is rescheduled or postponed, your ticket will automatically be valid for the new date. If a concert is canceled, your ticket will be converted to a donation unless you call or email symphony@ashland.edu to request a refund. Please keep in mind that the ASO incurs costs even if the event is canceled. Your gift helps to ensure that the ASO will be here for future generations.

Remember an empty seat gives no applause.

The seats in GREEN are Premium and \$28 each.

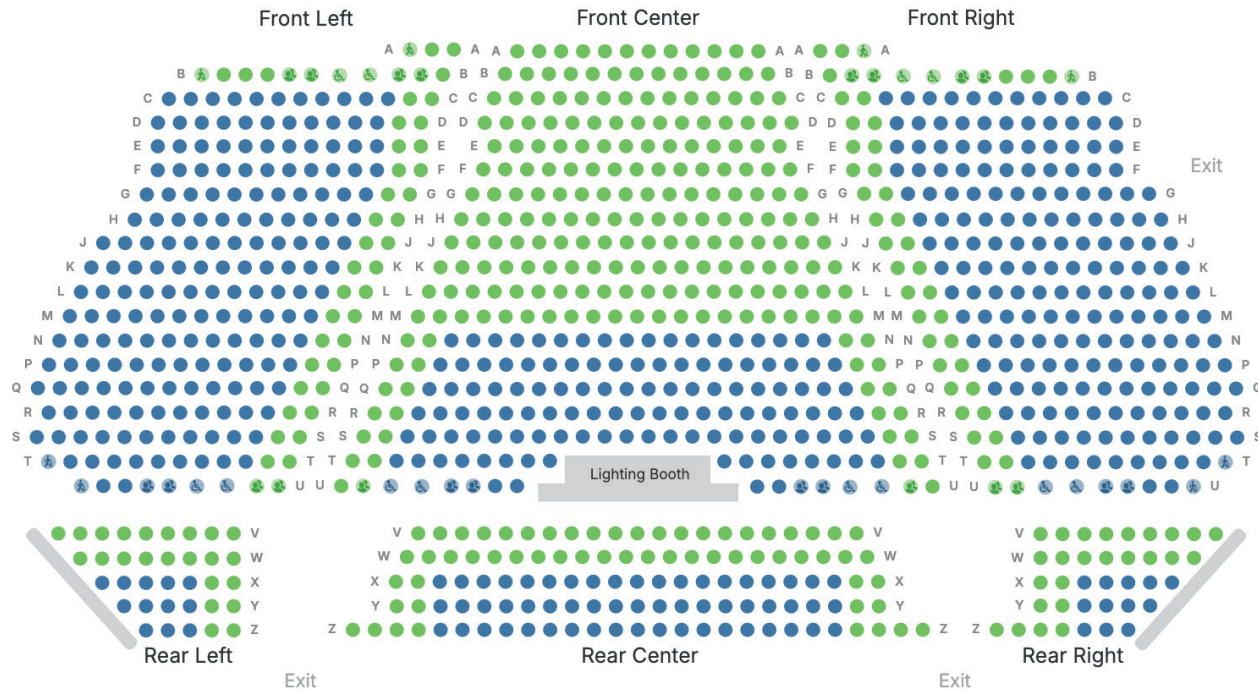
The seats in BLUE are Standard and \$24 each.
